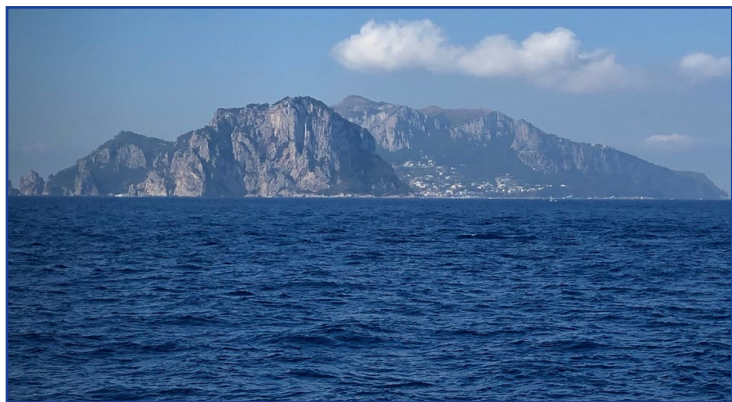
Singer John Kelly is becoming a fan favorite at Blaire House of Milford.

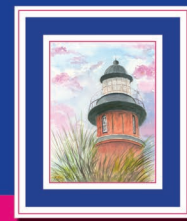
