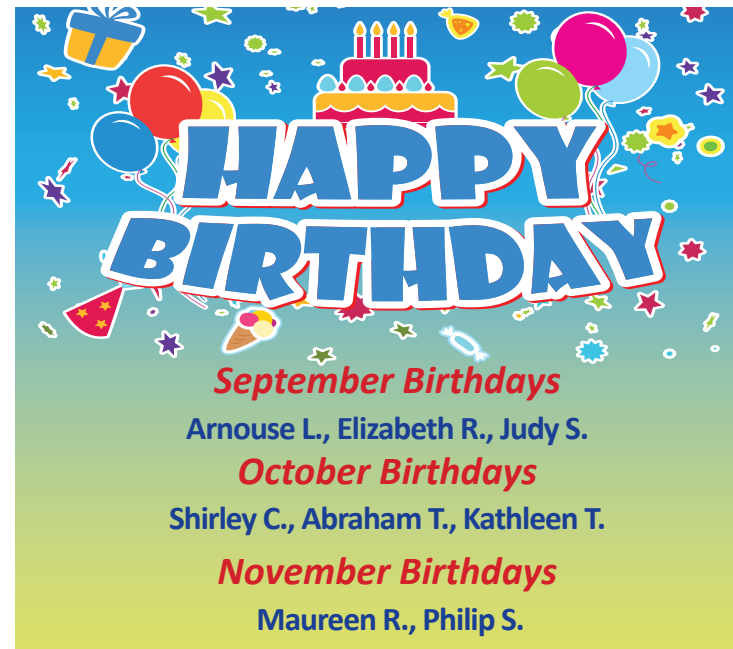
IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER:
