Protestant Nondenominational programming is every Sunday morning at 9 AM on DayStar.

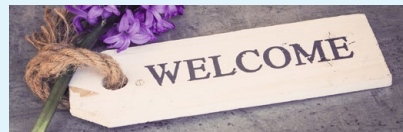

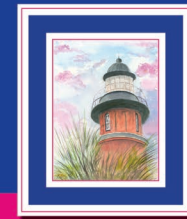
